CLARIFICATION OF TAX-DEDUCTIBLE DONATIONS: If an individual makes a donation to a non-profit organization and receives a direct benefit (in this case, the benefit might be groomed ski trails), then a portion of that donation is not tax deductible. The individual must decide the value of the direct benefit (i.e. \$50 for groomed ski trails) and subtract that from the donation. The remainder of the donation is tax-deductible.
